



**Inactive or
Dormant Accounts**



We will be reviewing all accounts to determine if they have had a transaction (deposit, withdrawal, or transfer) in the past 12 months. Accounts that have not had any activity within one year are considered dormant and will be charged a \$10.00 dormant account fee. If the account has not had any activity for 5 years, the SC Abandoned Property Act requires all financial institutions to turn over the funds in the account to the state. Per our fee schedule, we charge an annual fee of \$10 for dormant/inactive accounts.

If you have not made a transaction on your account in the past year, please come by the credit union or call us. Transfers or transactions can be done through MoneyLine 24 by calling 843-669-9099 or (866)-699-9099 (out of the area) and online at www.pdfcu.org.
