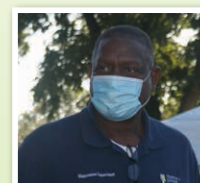

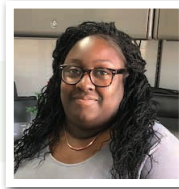
With our Skip-A-Payment program, we want to reward those members whose loans are in good standing, but they just need the flexibility that skipping a loan payment can create for them.

Notice: Year-End Statements

Your year-end statements contain valuable tax information such as total interest paid on loans and dividends you have earned on each account. If your accounts earned over \$10.00 in dividends, you will receive a 1099-INT. If you have a mortgage with the credit union and paid over \$600.00 in interest, you will receive a 1098 Form. Remember, if you have an IRA with us, your year-end balance will be reported to the IRS as your Fair Market Value. Year-end statements can be accessed through your online banking account.
